The Stock Exchange of Thailand (SET) has revised regulations regarding circuit breaker and ceiling & floor of the listed securities to cope with the severe market situations. The revised regulations will be in effective from 18 March 2020 until the date specified by SET, which will not be later than 30 June 2020. Please refer to the regulations attached for more information. Details of the adjustment are as follows:

1. Circuit Breaker are revised the triggers from 2 to 3 levels with different trading halt periods.

Level	Current		Adjustment	
	SET Index	Trading halt	SET Index	Trading halt
level 1	-10%	30 minutes	-8%	30 minutes
level 2	-20%	60 minutes	-15%	30 minutes
level 3	-	-	-20%	60 minutes

2. Ceiling & Floor of each securities are revised to:

Type of securities	Current	Adjustment
2.1) Securities (in general)	+/- 30%	+/- 15% of the previous day's closing price
2.2) Securities Held by Foreign Nationals	+/- 60%	+/- 30% of the previous day's closing price of the Securities under 2.1)
2.3) - Transferable Subscription Rights - Warrant - DW	+/- 30%	+/- 15% of the previous day's closing price of the underlying asset, multiplied by a conversion ratio
