Re: Sector Reclassifications in 2005.

Attachments: 1) The definition and structure of industry groups and business sectors in 2005. 2) Reconsideration of proper placement of business sectors' listed companies.

Since January 1, 2004, The Stock Exchange of Thailand (SET) has introduced a new classification system; grouping related business sectors under 8 industry groups. This new system groups the sectors that tend to have the same business operation movements together in order to more clearly represent and accommodate the diverse core businesses of the listed firms.

For the next step, the SET has planned to reclassify the sectors again as well as reconsider whether currently all listed companies are grouped in their most appropriate sectors, and if not, reclassify them. This operation will be undertaken in 2005 by reclassifying the business sectors in three ways:

1. Rename the business sectors but keep the existing definitions. Three sectors will be changed as follows:

3. Combine related business sectors which have the same business operation movements. Four sectors will be unified to create two new sectors as follows:
