

FISN (Financial Instrument Short Name)

FISN provide a consistent and uniform approach to standardize short descriptions for financial instruments.

The structure of the FISN:

The FISN consists of maximum length of 35 alphanumeric characters:

1. Issuer short name - abbreviation of the official issuer name, limited to a maximum of 15 alphanumeric characters

2. Instrument description - abbreviation of characteristics and attributes defining a financial instrument, limited to a maximum of 19 alphanumeric characters

Note: “/” - the delimiter between the issuer short name and the instrument description

FISN of e.g. : common share: **“ABCDEF GH PUBLIC/LCL SH VTG FPD”**
